#### **INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS**

# Every abstract must include:

- 1. **Title** (maximum 200 characters).
- 2. **Authors' names** (first name followed by last name; the name of the **presenting author** should be underlined), and authors' affiliations.
- 3. **Main text** (maximum 300 words), structured into: Introduction, Materials and Methods, Results, Conclusions.
- 4. **Figures and Tables** (maximum 2 elements): either 1 table and 1 figure, or 2 tables and no figures, or 2 figures and no tables.
- 5. **Keywords:** maximum of 3, listed in alphabetical order.
- 6. **References:** each abstract should include up to 5 references. Reference style:
  - 1. Author, A.B.; Author, C.D. Title of the article. Abbreviated Journal Name Year, Volume, page range.

\*The text must be written in Calibri font, size 12, with single line spacing.
